

Digital Pictures

Ten photos must be taken of each vehicle in order to illustrate its overall condition. The photos should be 2MB in size. The photos will be centered on the vehicle and show as little of the surrounding view (adjacent vehicles, skyline, etc.) as possible. Photos must be taken in the following manner:

First Photo - Taken at an angle from the passenger's side front bumper. The picture must show the front bumper and the entire passenger side.

Second Photo - Taken at an angle from the driver's side front bumper. Picture must show the front bumper and the entire driver's side.

Third Photo - Taken at an angle from the driver's side rear bumper. Picture must show the rear bumper and entire driver's side.

Fourth Photo - Taken at an angle from the passenger side rear bumper. Picture must show the rear bumper and the entire passenger side.

Fifth Photo - Taken from the open passenger front door. Picture must show the entire dash area, including steering wheel, airbags and radio. Photo must be taken with the flash in the ON position.

Sixth Photo - Taken from an open door or lift gate, whichever one shows the best view of the rear of the passenger compartment. Picture must show if parts are missing. Photo must be taken with the flash in the ON position.

Seventh Photo - Taken straight over the engine, hood open, and facing down. Picture should be a close up shot of the engine. Use a 4-foot stick such as a section of an old broomstick to hold the hood open if the holding mechanism is not functional. If the hood cannot be opened take the picture of the front bumper and the hood.

Eighth Photo - Taken from the driver's seat. Photo must show a close up of the odometer reading so it can be read clearly. Even if the odometer is not operational or is damaged, the photo must be taken.

Ninth and Tenth Photo - Unique to each lot based upon vehicle condition. Using your best judgment, take a photo that will present members with as much detail as possible concerning damage to and/or highlight the positive features of the vehicle.

Digital Pictures of Commercial Trailers

Ten photos must be taken of each commercial trailer in order to illustrate its overall condition. The photos should be 2MB in size. The photos will be centered on the trailer and show as little of the surrounding view (adjacent vehicles, skyline, etc.) as possible. Photos must be taken in the following manner:

First Photo - Taken at an angle from the left front corner. Picture must show front of trailer and entire left side of trailer.

Second Photo - Taken straight ahead from the front of the trailer.

Third Photo - Taken at an angle from the right front corner. Picture must show front of trailer and entire right side of trailer.

Fourth Photo - Taken at an angle from the left rear corner. Picture must show rear of trailer and entire left side of trailer.

Fifth Photo - Taken at an angle from the right rear corner. Picture must show rear of trailer and entire right side of trailer.

Sixth Photo - Taken straight on the rear of the trailer, doors closed.

Seventh Photo - Taken straight on the rear of the trailer, doors open, showing floor of trailer.

Eighth Photo - Taken straight on the rear of the trailer, doors open, showing roof of trailer.

Ninth and Tenth Photo - Unique to each lot based upon vehicle condition. Using your best judgment, take a photo that will present members with as much detail as possible concerning damage to and/or positive features of the vehicle.
